

**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**  
**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed Bids will be received by the CITY OF CHELSEA, ALABAMA at the Council Chambers, City Hall, located at 1161 Chelsea Road, Chelsea, Al. 35043 until 10:00 A.M. o'clock, (LOCAL TIME), July 31, 2008 for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, and equipment, and for doing the work, according to Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents on file in CITY HALL of said CITY OF CHELSEA, ALABAMA for installation of roadway improvements on Old U.S. Highway 280 for the Double J & O Development and associated work hereinafter described. No bids will be received after the time set forth hereinabove; and the proposals will be publicly opened and read.

The work shall consist of approximately 790 C.Y. unclassified earth cut and fill, 2,600 C.Y. imported compacted fill, 600 C.Y. topsoil, 2,004 s.y. 8" compacted dense grade base, 475 tons asphalt binder, 110 tons 1" asphalt wearing surface, 130 tons 1" asphalt wearing surface (overlay), 78 l.f. 24" R.C. pipe Cl. III, 500 l.f. galvanized guardrails, 2 Ea. guardrail end sections, etc.

Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents are open to public inspection at the City Hall of CITY OF CHELSEA, ALABAMA or may be obtained from the office of the Engineers, Spencer Engineering, Inc. 3237 Lorna Road, Birmingham, Alabama, 35216, upon deposit of \$ 50.00 per set. Said deposit is non-refundable and covers the cost of reproduction of plans and specifications.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in any bid, and to accept any bid considered advantageous to the Owner.

No bid will be withdrawn after the time for opening of bids has passed. The Owner reserves the right to hold the bids for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of receiving the bids.

A certified check or bid bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid must accompany each proposal not to exceed \$10,000.00. The payee of such check, or the obligee of such bond, shall be the CITY OF CHELSEA.

The successful bidder must furnish a Performance Bond for one hundred (100%) percent of the bid amount, and must secure his bond for a bonding company's representative or agent in the State of Alabama.

The Contractor shall obtain and pay for all licenses and permits required by the State, County, or City authorities having jurisdiction over the various phases of the work.

The attention of all bidders is called to the provisions of State Lay Governing General Contractors, as set forth in Chapter 4 (Section

65 to 82, inclusive) of Title 46 of the Code of Alabama for 1940, as amended; and bidders shall be governed by said law insofar as it is applicable. The above mentioned provisions of the Code make it illegal for the Owner to consider a bid from anyone who is not properly licensed under such code provisions. The Owner, therefore will not consider any bid unless the bidder produces evidence that he is so licensed. Neither will the Owner enter into a Contract with a foreign corporation, which is not qualified under State Law to do business in the State of Alabama.
