Regular Session

The City Council of the City of Chelsea, Alabama, met in regular council session on June 20h, 2017, at 6:05 P.M. at Chelsea City Hall. Mayor Tony Picklesimer called the meeting to order and Pastor Allan Murphy from North Shelby Baptist Church opened the meeting with prayer. The pledge of allegiance was led by Councilmember Scott Weygand.

Mayor Picklesimer declared a quorum present.

A motion to approve the minutes as written from the Regular Council Meeting on June 6th, 2017, was made by Casey Morris and seconded by David Ingram. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Proposed Resolution 2017-06-20-626 for a resolution to authorize a restaurant retail liquor, wine, and beer license for JMJAC Restaurant (Johnny Ray's) was presented by Mayor Picklesimer. A motion to approve this resolution was made by David Ingram and seconded by Scott Weygand. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Proposed Resolution 2017-06-20-627 for a resolution to appoint Becky Landers as the Chelsea Municipal Court Clerk/Magistrate and Kim Mims as the Chelsea Municipal Court Magistrate was presented by Mayor Picklesimer. A motion to approve this resolution was made by Cody Sumners and seconded by Tiffany Bittner. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Proposed Resolution 2017-06-20-628 for a resolution to appoint Mark Boardman and Grant Howard as the Chelsea Municipal Court Prosecutors and Andrea Graham as the Municipal Court Public Defender Mayor Picklesimer was presented by Mayor Picklesimer. A motion to approve this resolution was made by Cody Sumners and seconded by Casey Morris. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Proposed Ordinance 2017-06-20-742 for an ordinance to establish the Municipal Court Corrections Fund and the monthly Municipal Court Date & Time was presented by Mayor Picklesimer. A motion to suspend the rules for immediate consideration was made by David Ingram and seconded by Tiffany Bittner. A roll call vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes". A motion to approve this ordinance was made by Cody Sumners and seconded by Scott Weygand. A roll call vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

The approval of the City of Chelsea Bills to be paid was next on the agenda. A motion was made by Casey Morris and seconded by David Ingram to approve to pay the bills. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

At this time Mayor Picklesimer announced that our Chelsea Municipal Court Team is now complete and we will have the Oath of Office ceremonies for the Municipal Court Judge, the Municipal Court Clerk/Magistrate and the Municipal Court Magistrate.

The Oath of Office for the Honorable Jeffrey Hester as the Chelsea Municipal Court Judge was administered by the Honorable Hewitt (Sonny) Conwill who is a Circuit Court Judge for Shelby County. Mr. Hester was accompanied for this honor by his wife Anna Hester.


