Regular Session

The City Council of the City of Chelsea, Alabama, met in regular council session on August 15th, 2017, at 6:00 P.M. at Chelsea City Hall. Mayor Tony Picklesimer called the meeting to order and Pastor Danny Lovett from The Church at Chelsea Westover opened the meeting with prayer. The pledge of allegiance was led by Councilmember Cody Summers.

Mayor Picklesimer declared a quorum present.

A motion to approve the minutes as presented from the Regular Council Meeting on August 1st, 2017, was made by Casey Morris and seconded by David Ingram. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Proposed Resolution 2017-08-15-632 for a resolution to dedicate the City of Chelsea Community Center in honor of former Mayor S. Earl Niven, Sr. was presented by Mayor Picklesimer. Mayor Niven was very instrumental in the development, design, and construction of the Chelsea Community Center the appropriate signage will be placed on the exterior of the building in his honor. A motion to approve this resolution was made by David Ingram and seconded by Scott Weygand. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Proposed Resolution 2017-08-15-633 for a resolution to contract with Kellis Vegetation Management, Inc., to do Chelsea Sports Parks grass overseeding services was also presented by Mayor Picklesimer. The grass overseeding will be for the Chelsea Hwy 39 Recreational Park Softball Fields, the Hwy 47 Recreational Complex, and the Hwy 11 Sports Complex Fields. The total cost for this service will be \$6,194.00. A motion to approve this resolution was made by Cody Summers and seconded by Tiffany Bittner. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

The approval of the City of Chelsea Bills to be paid was next on the agenda. A motion was made by Casey Morris and seconded by Scott Weygand to approve to pay the bills. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".

Mayor Picklesimer announced Shelby County Engineer Randy Cole and Sain Associates will present a plan involving the public to redesign the intersection at County Roads 39 and 47 in Chelsea after the adjournment of the council meeting. This is the road which runs in front of Chelsea City Hall and only a few feet from the railroad crossing. The road poses dangers due to the fact that a traffic light at the intersection causes cars to back up on the railroad tracks, as well as other factors that limit sight distance around the intersection.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was made by Scott Weygand and seconded by David Ingram. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".
