Regular Session

The City Council of the City of Chelsea, Alabama, met in regular council session on October 17th, 2017, at 6:10 P.M. at Chelsea City Hall. Mayor Tony Picklesimer called the meeting to order and Pastor Henry Prater from Union the Church at Chelsea Park UMC opened the meeting with prayer. Proposed Resolution 2017-10-17-644 for a resolution to accept a bid for drainage and pavement improvements to the Hwy 47 Sports Complex was presented by Mayor Picklesimer. The lowest and best bid of \$187,830.00 for these improvements was submitted by Central Alabama Asphalt & Construction Company, LLC. The bid includes a new drainage system at the park, which will help alleviate a problem of rainwater that sticks around for several days, as well as paving and striping of the parking lot. A motion to approve this resolution was made by David Ingram and seconded by Tiffany Bittner. A voice vote was taken and it was an unanimous, "Yes".


