The following elected officials were found to be present:



Regular Session

The City Council of the City of Chelsea, Alabama, met in regular council session on June 15th, 2021, at 6:00P.M. at Chelsea City Hall. Mayor Tony Picklesimer called the meeting to order. Wayne Honeycutt (Liberty Baptist Church) opened the meeting with prayer. Councilmember Scott Weygand led the council in the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Tony Picklesimer declared a quorum present.

A motion to approve the amended agenda was made by Scott Weygand and seconded by Chris Grace. A voice vote was taken and it was a unanimous, "Yes".

Next, a motion to approve the minutes as written from the Regular Council Meeting on June 1st, 2021 was made by Casey Morris and seconded by Cody Sumners. A voice vote was taken and it was a unanimous, "Yes".

Mayor Picklesimer gave an update on the Splashpad and the Hwy 39 & Hwy 47 project.

**Proposed Resolution 2021-06-15-920** to authorize Criterion K-12 Consulting, LLC to conduct a feasibility study for a City of Chelsea school system was next on the agenda. A motion to authorize the feasibility study was made by Casey Morris and seconded by Tiffany Bittner. A voice vote was taken in which Mayor Picklesimer and Councilmembers Weygand, Grace, Bittner, and Morris voted "Yes" and Councilmember Sumners voted "No".

**Proposed Resolution 2021-06-15-921** to engage Goodwyn, Mills, & Caywood, LLC to perform an assessment of Chelsea High School and potential capital improvements was next on the agenda. A motion to authorize the facilities assessment was made by Chris Grace and seconded by Scott Weygand. A voice vote was taken in which Mayor Picklesimer and Councilmembers Weygand, Grace, Bittner, and Morris voted "Yes" and Councilmember Sumners voted "No".

**Proposed Resolution 2021-06-15-922** to declare city property as surplus and authorize its disposal was next on the agenda. A motion to declare the itemized city property as surplus and authorize the disposal of said property was made by Casey Morris and seconded by Chris Grace. A voice vote was taken and it was a unanimous, "Yes".

Approval of City of Chelsea Bills to be paid was next on the agenda. A motion to approve paying the bills was made by Cody Sumners and seconded by Chris Grace. A voice vote was taken and it was a unanimous, "Yes".


During the Community Forum portion of the council meeting, several people addressed the City Council to express their opposition to and ask questions about the possibility of a City of Chelsea School System.
